2. amorous adj. Having a propensity for falling in love.
3. benign adj. Good and kind of heart.
4. cadence n. Rhythmical or measured flow or movement, as in poetry or the time and pace of marching troops.
5. concession n. Anything granted or yielded, or admitted in response to a demand, petition, or claim.
6. dearth n. Scarcity, as of something customary, essential, or desirable.
7. inadvertent adj. Accidental.
8. intolerance n. Inability or unwillingness to bear or endure.
9. intrepid adj. Fearless and bold.
10. jaundice n. A morbid condition, due to obstructed excretion of bile or characterized by yellowing of the skin.
11. kimono n. A loose robe, fastening with a sash, the principal outer garment in Japan.
